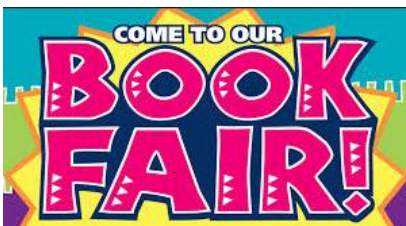
Online Safety Week

It has been a successful Online Safety Week in school with each class participating in a range of activities to help them think about, learn and discuss the importance of knowing how they can stay safe when using the Internet. In Squirrels Class, the children have been sharing how they use the Internet and linked to their Maths work by creating a chart about the activities they liked doing online. Hedgehogs Class worked on giving each other compliments and then created a kindness tree in the classroom.



The children in Badgers Class thought about the games, apps and websites they used that needed the Internet to work, as well as watching a clip about children who are faced with a problem when playing a game online. In Foxes Class, they designed safety posters for specific apps. Rabbits Class used drama strategies to discuss different scenarios around the subject. The children in Woodpeckers Class created a list of happy and sad experiences when using the Internet and developed strategies for dealing with these events. Owls Class had a visitor who talked to them in detail about the dangers online to develop their awareness of staying safe online.

The information on the blackboard at the front of school generated lots of discussion. The information was taken from the latest Digital Parenting Magazine, which will be coming home with your child this evening.
