Strengths of our school

"The teachers genuinely care about the children's progress."

Every parent replied that their child is **well looked after** at Uppingham C of E.

Everyone agreed that the school has a **calm, welcoming and relaxed atmosphere**.

All parents are satisfied with the school.

An overwhelming majority agree that their child **makes good progress**.

An overwhelming majority of parents agree that **staff expect their child to work hard and do his or her best**.

The significant majority think that the school ensures the **pupils are well behaved** with a minority disagreeing.

Almost all parents agreed that their child is **happy and safe** at school.

Almost all parents agreed that the school is **well led and managed** with a few parents who don't know. No one disagreed with the statement.

An overwhelming majority of parents agreed that the **school responds well to concerns** with a small minority not knowing. No one disagreed with this statement.

An overwhelming majority agreed that they **receive valuable information about their child's progress** with a few disagreeing.

A significant majority of parents agree that **homework builds well on what my child learns in school**.

Everyone feels **comfortable about approaching the school with questions, suggestions or a problem** or doesn't know.

Almost all parents think the school **encourages them to be involved in its life and work**.

The majority of parents commented that they had no experience of bullying or agreed that the **school deals effectively with bullying** and a few parents disagreed.

Almost all parents would recommend this school to another parent.

If you could change one thing, what would it be?

Responses can be grouped together into themes:

- Improving behaviour management in school – 6 comments
- More updates from school on progress and learning – 3 comments
- Quality of lessons – 3 comments
- Sufficient challenge for children – 2 comments
- Level of support for children – 2 comments
- Consistency of reward system – 2 comments

What are we going to be doing this term to make our school even better?

- School Council will be working in their classes collecting opinions from the children to help review the behaviour management policy which is also linked to the school reward scheme.
- Reviewing our behaviour management policy with all staff so that expectations are consistent across all classes and across the school day.
- We will continue developing and improving our teaching so that children have inspiring lessons that challenge them and enable them to make progress.
- Training up our new Playground Buddies for the summer term so they can play games and support children at break times.
