

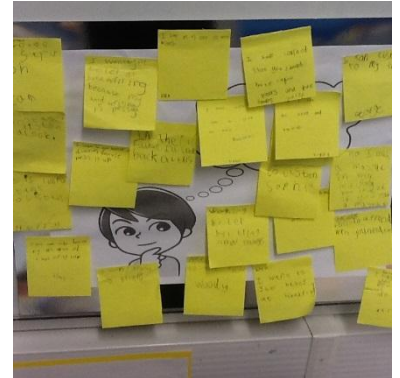
School News – Friday 23rd November 2018
