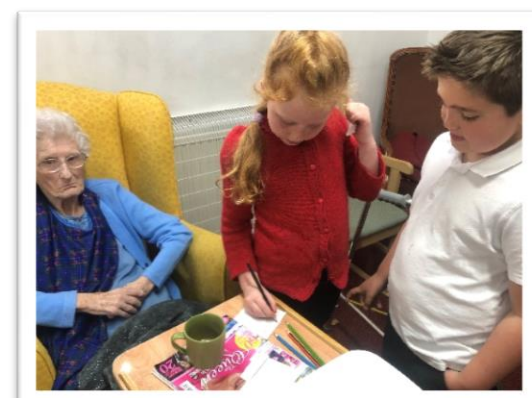
BE A POSITIVE SUPERHERO
