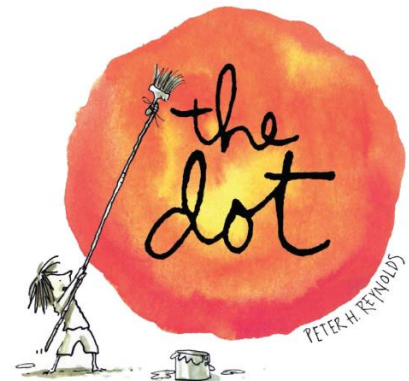


Art Week Special – Friday 28th June 2019

Make your mark!

This week has been art week and our theme was “Make your mark,” based on the book *The Dot* by Peter H Reynolds. In the book, a child who is struggling to draw, is encouraged by her teacher to “Just make a mark and see where it takes you.”

Throughout the week the children have had a real variety of experiences, all encouraging them to make their own mark in different ways. We had two artists leading workshops for the children. **Mike Alabaster** is a local artist, who teaches painting workshops at Stamford Arts Centre, he worked with the children teaching them how to draw a portrait of their friends. **Mo Gardner** is a Morcott based sculptor (she met the Queen recently to do with her work!) and she led sculpture workshops.



All the children have contributed to a huge whole school piece of art work and they have been very keen to spot their piece of work amongst the 150+ pieces on the wall!



Each class has also concentrated on a class project exploring different materials and ways of making a mark!
