Squirrels Class

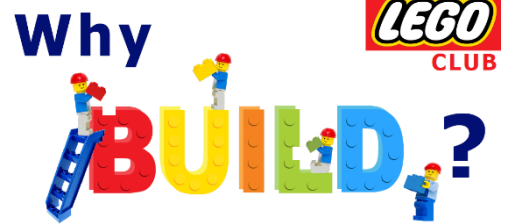
