

## School News – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2019

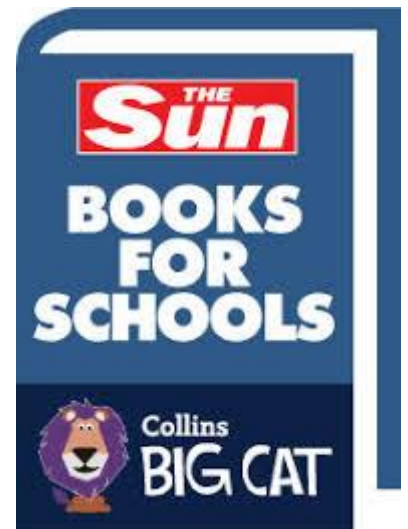
