

Maths

In Maths, we are initially revisiting fractions. We will then move on to decimals including adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing numbers with up to three decimal places. We will also look again at percentages and the relationship these have with fractions and decimals.

We will then be moving on to measurement, looking at both metric and imperial measures and finding perimeter and area of shapes.

Science

In Science, we are learning about Evolution and Inheritance. We will think about how living things have changed over time and see how fossils can help us to know about living things from millions of years ago.

We will see how living things produce offspring that are not identical to their parents and how animals and plants are adapted to their environment in different ways which may lead to evolution.

English

In English, we will be focussing on the text 'Floodland'. Using this text, the children will be creating informal letters, narrative stories and persuasive speeches. A biography will also be created about a famous environmentalist.

We will also be looking at balanced arguments and debates. Facts and opinions will be able to be distinguished as well as being able to identify the features of an argument. A debate will then be held discussing the pros and cons of using media.

Furthermore, Narrative poetry will be explored using the poem 'The Highwayman'. Children will take part in different drama activities to retell the story as well as creating their own narrative poems.

Whole class reading lessons, Read, Write Inc spellings and Grammar sessions will also take place each week.

Geography

'There is No Planet B'

During Term 5 and 6, we will be learning how to live as global citizens. It is inspired by the idea that we all have a responsibility to help the environment and all living things throughout the world through the choices we make. We will explore the ideas of sustainability, the use of the earth's natural resources and the harmful effects of global warming. In this unit, we will also learn about the steps that can be taken to reduce these harmful effects.

RE and PSHE

In RE we are learning about how people of various religions care for the Earth and its inhabitants.

During Term 5 and 6 in PSHE, we will be focussing on Health and wellbeing and discussing these 3 main questions: How can we improve our physical and mental health? What is personal identity? How can we help in an emergency?

PE, ART/DT, Music

In PE, we are learning the skills and drills of Rounders as well as learning a dance routine that can be performed to an audience.

In Art, our focus artist is Banksy. We will be discussing the techniques he uses as well as creating a piece of art in his style.

In DT, we are learning how to combine different fabrics and by the end of the unit, a felt phone case will be created.
