

Maths

This term in Maths we will be covering:

- Unit and non-units fractions; halves, thirds, quarters and tenths.
- Equivalent fractions.
- Add and subtract fractions
- Tenths and hundredths as decimals
- Compare, order and round decimals.
- Measurement—time and money
- Statistic—bar charts and line graphs
- Properties of shape

Science

In Science this term, we will be studying 'States of Matter'. The children will be learning the differences between solids, liquids and gases and how materials change state. They will be able to take part in lots of practical investigations to help them understand the processes of evaporation and condensation.

English

We will be linking our topic 'Our Changing World' to our English this term. We will begin by looking at a book called There's a Rang-Tan in My Bedroom, which looks at the impact of deforestation. We will be writing diary entries, reports, as well as persuasive letters.

In our Whole Class Reading sessions, we will be continuing to develop our reading skills (Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanations, Retrieval, Summaries and Sequences)

This term, we will continue with our new interactive spelling programme, which aims to teach spelling in a fun and engaging way! Weekly spelling tests will take place on Fridays.

Geography

Our topic this term is called Our Changing World. The children will begin this unit by learning the difference between weather and climate. They will be using their map reading skills to locate the different climate zones around the world and learning why these zones exist.

Following on from this, the children will be learning about climate change; what is causing it and the effects it is having on Planet Earth.

The children will conclude the topic by investigating what is currently being done to combat climate change and what they can do as individuals.

RE and PSHCE

In RE we will be asking the question, '**How should we care for the world and for others and why does it matter?**' The children will learn from different religious and spiritual ways of life about how people care for other people and for the world.

In PSHCE we are focusing on our physical health and mental wellbeing, in particular we can make healthy choices.

PE, Music, DT, French

During our PE sessions, we will be focusing on striking and fielding games. We will also be taking part in athletic activities.

In DT we will be researching, designing and making our own pencil cases. We will learn how to use a variety of stitches, as well as how to decorate our pencil case creations!

In Music we will be focusing on composition, which will be linked to our topic Our Changing World.

This term in our French lessons we will be discussing buying things like toys and expressing our likes and dislikes.
