

Maths

In Maths we will be learning about fractions. We will learn about wholes and parts.. We will learn about halves, quarters and thirds and recognise what these look like in different contexts (shapes, lengths and sets of objects. We learn about $1/2$ and $2/4$ being equivalent fractions.

Later in the term we will move onto measures (mass, length and time.) We will compare, measure and order measures . We will use the correct vocabulary for each standard unit of measure. We will learn to tell the time using the words o 'clock,, quarter past, half past and quarter to. We will also read the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

Science

In Science we will be building upon our work on habitats and learning about food chains. We will find out how animals obtain their foods from plants and animals.

Later in the term we will learn about plants. We will plant seeds and investigate what they need in order to grow well , making observations.

English

In English we are learning about recounts and we will write our own recounts based upon books and virtual trips. We are going to explore adventure stories, and also stories written by the same author. We will look at poetry based around the theme of dragons and create acrostic and shape poems. In Whole Class Reading sessions we will develop our inference skills.

The grammar we will focus on this term will include;
tense
conjunctions—time words
apostrophes for possession
adding suffixes

History / Geography and Computing

In History we are learning about significant historical places in our local area with a focus on Rockingham Castle. Later in the term we will develop our knowledge of the local area and complete a comparative study Uppingham/ Rutland and a place in a Non-European Country.

In Computing we are learning about simple programmes using the beebots to support our learning. We will begin to understand what debugging is and use our knowledge to correct errors in programmes. Later in the term we will develop our coding skills using Scratch Junior.

RE and PSHE

In RE we are learning about festivals across the main world religions. Later in the term we will focus on Christianity focusing on Jesus and the good news he brought.
